Pattern:	Patchwork Wheel
Block Size:	12½" x 12½" (with seam allowances); 12" x 12" (finished)
Colors:	Black for Background (not the gray shown in the picture); Multiple Prints for Color



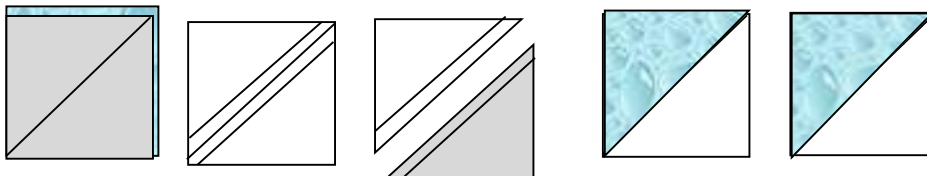
Cutting Instructions below for **ONE** block

Color	Number to Cut	Cutting Instructions
Prints	8	3 ½" squares
	4	4 ½" squares
Black	4	4 ½" squares

Sewing Instructions:

You will use half-square triangles for this block.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the gray squares. Then, match up each gray square with a printed square, right sides together, with the drawn line facing you. Stitch a scant ¼" seam on either side of the line, then cut along the line to create two half-square triangles (HSTs).



Repeat the process with all of the 4 ½" gray squares and print squares.

2. Press the HSTs and trim to 3 ½" square.
3. Sew the HSTs and print 3 ½" squares together in rows as shown below.



4. Stitch rows together, taking care to line up seams as you go.
