


LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza

THE TRIPLE FOUR-PATCH BLOCK – DUE OCTOBER 17, 2016

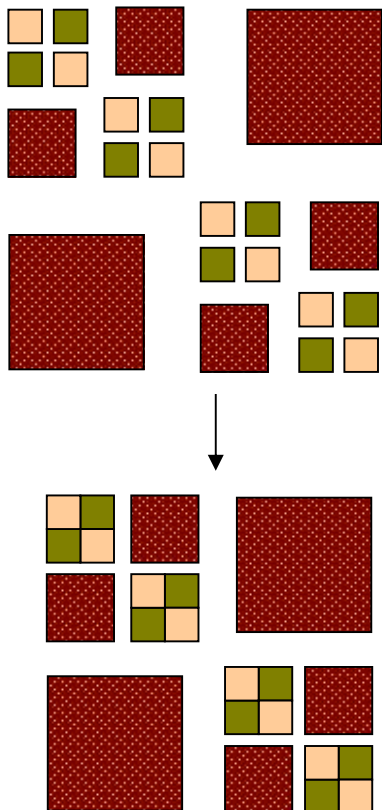
You can make **ONE** block... **OR** you can make **TWO** blocks **AND** be eligible for the lottery block drawing! Make as many pairs as you wish. The drawing to win the second set of blocks will be held at the Guild meeting on the night of the block due date. Sample blocks and instructions can be seen at www.lakeviewquiltersguild.org.

Due	Monday, October 17, 2016 at the Guild meeting	
Pattern	Triple Four-Patch	
Block Size	Unfinished: 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" Finished: 10" x 10"	
Colors	Use an earth-tone fabric for Color A (brown, tan, orange, rust, gold, green) for all the background squares. Use another earth-tone fabric for some of the small squares (Color B) and an off-white or light tan for Color C for the rest of the small squares.	

Cutting Instructions for ONE block:

Color	Number to Cut	Size
Color A (earth tone 1)	2	5-1/2" square
	4	3" square
Color B (earth tone 2)	8	1-3/4" square (see alternative below)
Color C (off-white or light tan)	8	1-3/4" square (see alternative below)

Sewing Instructions for ONE block:



1. Lay out the units for this block.
2. Sew the smaller four-patches together.
3. Sew the medium-sized four-patches together.
4. Sew the large four-patch together, completing the block. The block should measure 10-1/2 inches square (unfinished size).

Alternative: To make the smaller four-patches, cut a 1-3/4 by 15" long strip of Color B and Color C. Stitch the strips together and then sub-cut the strip into 1-3/4" subunits. Sew pairs of them together to make four-patches.
