


LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza LOUISIANA BLOCK – DUE SEPTEMBER 19, 2016

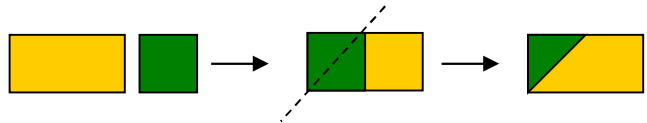
Due	Monday, September 19, 2016 at the Guild meeting	
Pattern	Louisiana	
Block Size	Unfinished: 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" Finished: 12" x 12"	
Colors	Fall Colors: Choose three different colors Use greens, golds, rusts, or browns, dark purples, dark reds, etc.	

Cutting Instructions for ONE block:

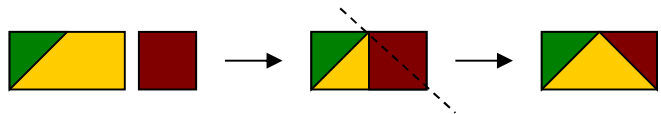
Color	Number to Cut	Size
Color 1 (background)	4	3-1/2 x 6-1/2" rectangle
	4	3-1/2" square
Color 2 (large pinwheel)	4	3-1/2 x 6-1/2" rectangle
Color 3 (small pinwheel)	4	3-1/2" square

Sewing Instructions for ONE block:

1. With right sides together, place one Color 1 square on one end of the Color 2 rectangle. Stitch diagonally across the small square. Fold the square open and trim away the excess fabric from beneath the unit.



2. With right sides together, place one Color 3 square on the other end of the Color 2 rectangle. Stitch diagonally across the small square. Fold the square open and trim away the excess fabric from beneath the unit.



3. Repeat steps 1 and 2, making a total of four units.
4. Using all of the units, assemble the block, as shown.
