


**LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza**  
**THE BROKEN DISH BLOCK – DUE FEBRUARY 20, 2017**

You can make **ONE** block... **OR** you can make **TWO** blocks **AND** be eligible for the lottery block drawing! Make as many pairs as you wish. The drawing to win the second set of blocks will be held at the Guild meeting on the night of the block due date. 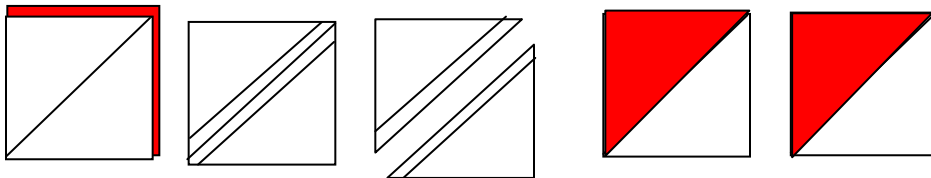
<b>Due</b>	February 20, 2017 at the Guild meeting	
<b>Pattern</b>	Broken Dish	
<b>Block Size</b>	6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (with seam allowance) 6" x 6" (finished)	
<b>Colors</b>	Red prints White-on-white	

**Sewing Instructions for ONE block:**

Color	Number to Cut	Cutting Instructions
Red print	2	3-7/8" square
White-on-white	2	3-7/8" square

You will need four half-square triangles for this block.

First, mark the two white squares diagonally through the center. (This will be a cutting line when you are finished.) Place a white square and a red square right sides together. Sew on either side of the drawn line, exactly 1/4 inch from the first line. Cut the squares in half on the cutting line. You now have two half-square triangles.



Repeat the process so that you have four half-square triangles.

Follow the pattern below to put together the broken dishes block.
