
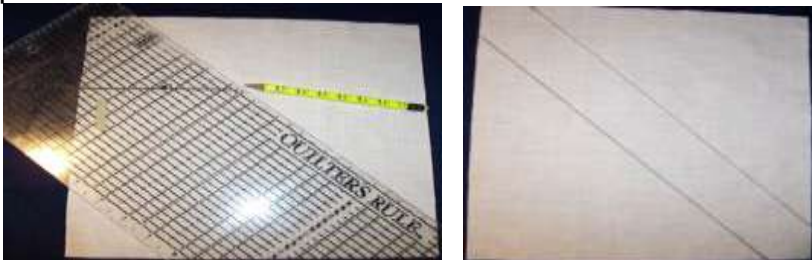


Scrappy String Block with Black Center

Due:	March 20, 2017 at the guild meeting	
Pattern:	Scrappy String Block	
Block Size:	(8½" x 8½") with seam allowances (8" x 8") finished	
Colors/ Guidelines:	Center strip should be 2" wide, black solid or black tone-on-tone print that reads solid black. Remaining strings can be any width/color/pattern you choose - anything goes. Here's a chance to use up some of those scraps!	

Start with a 9" block of muslin for the base. Fold the muslin square in half diagonally and press a crease. Draw a line one inch from the crease on both sides of the crease.



Place the 2" strip of black fabric, right side up, in the center of the fabric, using the pencil marks as the guide. Place the next strip of fabric along one of the edges of the center strip, right side down (fabrics will be right sides together) and sew ¼" from edge. Flip second strip right side up and press. Continue this method until you have covered one side of the block. Then proceed with this same method for the other side of the block. The block will end up with a 1 ½" black center.



The block will have uneven edges. Press the block and trim it down to 8 ½", keeping the black string in the center.
