


LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza

SAILBOAT BLOCK – DUE JUNE 19, 2017

You can make **ONE** block... **OR** you can make **TWO** blocks **AND** be eligible for the lottery block drawing! 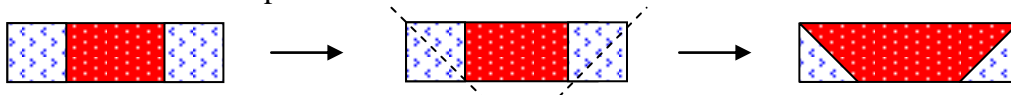
Due	Monday, June 19, 2017 at the Guild meeting	
Pattern	Sailboat	
Block Size	Unfinished: 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" Finished: 10" x 10"	
Fabric Colors	Boat: Red or Blue Sails: Red, White, or Blue Water: Blue Sky: Any fabric that makes a good "sky" background	

Cutting instructions for ONE block:

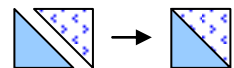
Color	Number to Cut	Size
Blue (water)	1	3 x 10-1/2" rectangle
Red or Blue (boat)	1	3" x 10-1/2" rectangle
Red, White, or Blue (sails)	2	3-3/8" square; halve each diagonally
Sky	2	3 x 5-1/2" rectangles
	2	3" squares
	2	3-3/8" square; halve each diagonally

Sewing instructions:

1. With right sides together, place one 3" Sky square on each end of the Red Boat strip, as shown in the diagram. Sew diagonally across the small squares. Fold the triangles down and press; trim the excess fabric off of the back of the strip.



2. Make four half-square triangles.
 - a. First, place a White or Off-white triangle on a Sky triangle, right sides together; stitch along the diagonal line.
 - b. Press the half-square triangle open, pressing the seam allowance toward the darker (sky) fabric.
 - c. Repeat, making four half-square triangles.



3. Using all of the units, assemble the ship block, as shown.
