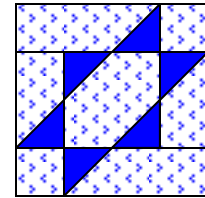


LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza THE SHOOTING STAR – DUE SEPTEMBER 18, 2017

Due:	September 18, 2017 at the Guild meeting.
Pattern:	Shooting Star
Block	8 1/2" x 8 1/2" with seam allowances
Size:	8" x 8" finished
Colors:	Brights – tone on tone for star points Off-white to light beige for a background

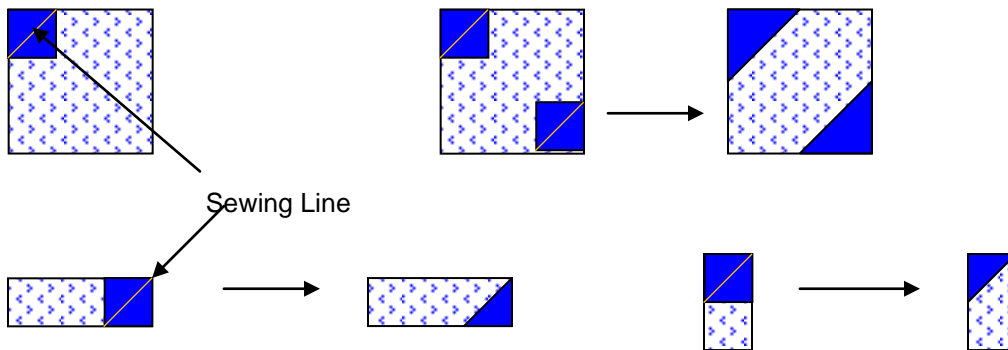


Cutting instructions for **ONE** block:

Color / Fabric	Number to Cut	Size
Off white to light beige for background	1	4 1/2 " square
	2	4 1/2" x 2 1/2 " rectangle
	2	6 1/2 " x 2 1/2" rectangle
	2	2 1/2" square
Tone on tone bright for star points	6	2 1/2 " squares

Sewing instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (6) bright 2 1/2" squares. Sew 2 on opposite corners of the background square. Sew 1 on each of the 4 rectangles as shown.
Note - on the rectangles pay particular attention to the direction of the sewing line to ensure triangle is positioned properly.



2. Trim away excess fabric leaving 1/4" past the seam and press towards the dark color.
3. Assemble blocks as shown below with squares to create shooting star.
